	16 th of Abib Friday	Day 2	Mat 27:62	Preparation Day	Jesus lay in his tomb for two nights.
	17 th of Abib Saturday	Day 3	Mat 27:62 Mat 28:1	Day after the Preparation day Sabbath The Resurrection The two Marys discover that Jesus had been resurrected.	The chief priests insure someone is watching the tomb as the 3 rd night draws nigh. Jesus lay in his tomb for three nights and is resurrected before dawn.
	18 th of Abib Sunday	Day 4	Mat 28:1	The First Day, Sunday	The day after Jesus was resurrected. Jesus appears to the Marys, then to the other disciples.

	15 th of Abib Thursday	Day 1	Luke 22:63 Luke 23:1-46	The Crucifixion	Jesus flogged by the chief priest and elders then taken to Pilate and crucified. Jesus lay in his tomb for one night.
	16 th of Abib Friday	Day 2	Luke 23:54	Preparation Day Friday	Jesus is placed in the tomb by Joseph of Arimathea.
	17 th of Abib Saturday	Day 3	Luke 23:56	Sabbath/ Saturday The Resurrection	Jesus lay in his tomb for three nights and is resurrected before the dawn of the first day of the week.
	18 th of Abib Sunday	Day 4	Luke 24:1 Luke 24:21	The First Day, Sunday	Women who followed Jesus from Galilee discover that Jesus had been resurrected. He appeared to Mary Magdalene The 3 rd day since Jesus was hung on the cross.
